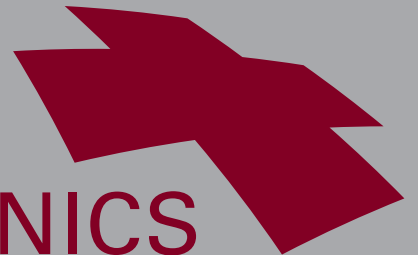

MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM

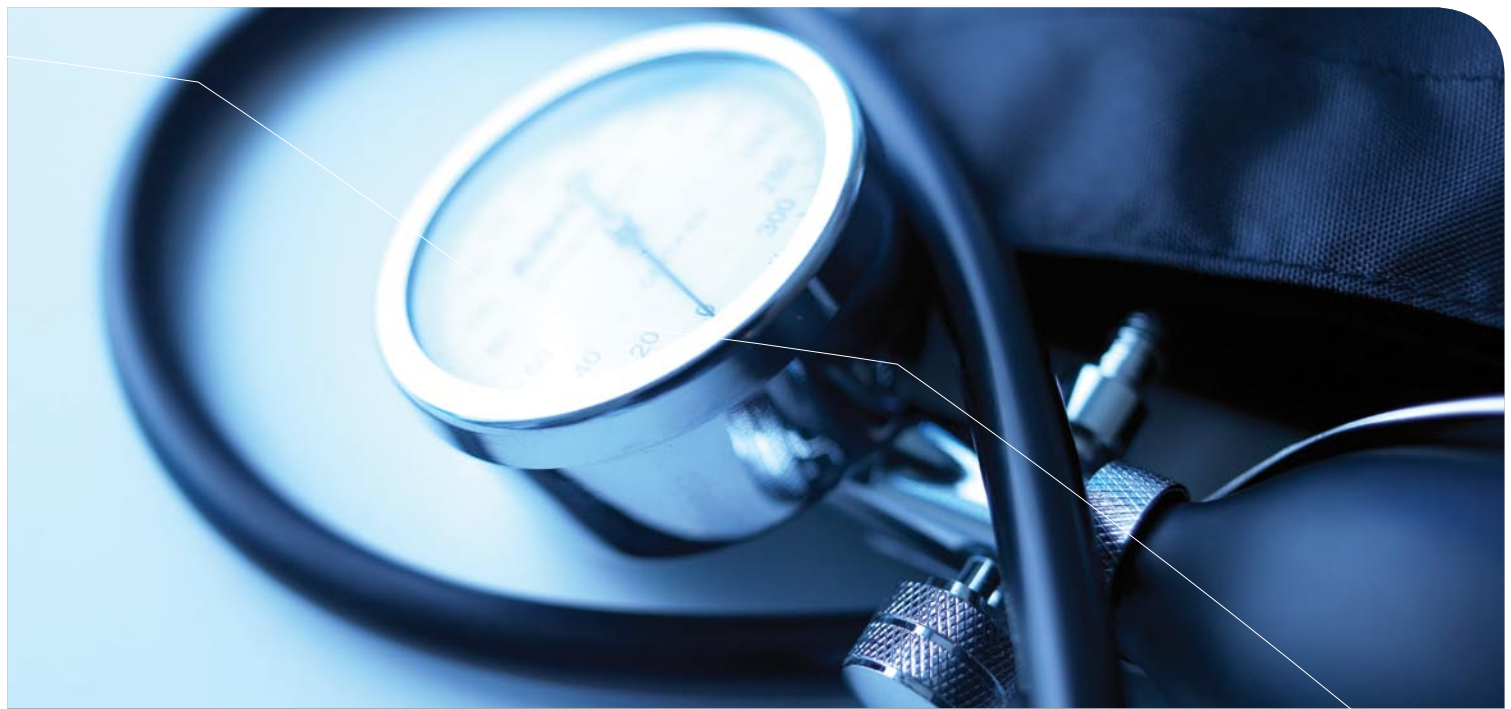
Chemtronics has developed an advanced computerised information system which provides asset management, analyses equipment history and provides real-time tracking of service workflow and costs.
